



Notice for Yachtspeople

Moorings:

Visitors are advised that moorings offered for rent in Port Elizabeth Harbour are unauthorized by the Port Authority, not inspected and not insured. Persons using and paying for such a mooring do so at their own risk. Any instances of harassment at anchor or on such a mooring should be reported to the Port Authority.

If anchoring at Princess Margaret or Lower Bay, you are required to keep 200 yards/meters off shore as these bays are zoned by the Port Authority as swimming areas.

Yacht Garbage Disposal:

Ashore, there is only one place to dispose of marine garbage - the skips located near the Fish Market Jetty, next to the vegetable market. These are exclusively reserved for yacht use. At sea, garbage in bags may be delivered to Daffodil Marine or any responsible water taxi who will give the assurance that it will be delivered to these skips. The charge varies from EC \$3.00 - \$5.00 per bag depending on its size.

No garbage should be delivered to anyone else or deposited anywhere else. Dumping in unauthorized places is a prosecutable offence.

Live-aboard Pets:

The Dept. of Agriculture & Veterinary Services regrets that, without a permit issued by our local veterinary services, it cannot allow the landing ashore of "boat dogs" anywhere in St. Vincent & the Grenadines due to the incidence of rabies and some fur borne diseases in countries and islands nearby. SVG is rabies-free and its dependence on agriculture and animal husbandry requires that it protect its people and farming base from threats of disease. Unauthorized dogs ashore are liable to be shot on sight.
